Our efforts, research, discussions and meetings, have been to gather the perspective of opportunity, and to frame potential candidates.

Our evaluations have included discussions or exchanges with various groups, including those who are familiar with mining in Africa.

TASMD Opportunity: our overall focus remains and is the alluvial deposits of diamond and gold, and as applicable, rare earths.

It remains our goal to see gold purchasing programs from the artisan's already working on the concessions designed to expand and improve conditions on the concession; if and when applicable, we also foresee or anticipate several methods that may improve recoverable assets; for example, it may be that we can implement an oxide mineralization exploration and development plan designed to result in oxide gold recovery through gravity/wash plant operations on concession areas.

Market:

We have also expended the effort to determine that industry results indicate that artisans typically recover about 30% of available gold using crude methods by hand. Modern mechanized methods are able to recover an additional 60% at the rate of 200 tons/hour. This increased capacity may be applicable in some areas of our grant and license. We will determine some of these options in next stage evaluation and planning with Narrogate.

Field reports on other projects by third parties have indicated that one measure of gold recovery is a usual rate of recovery about 30% (approximately 15 ounces per day), which leaves 60+% for wash plant recovery operations.

Our goal is to continue good harmony in working with the local artisans, improving or introducing better methods for effective extraction and with health considerations. As demonstrated in our discussions with our partner Narrogate, as implemented in each project location, we believe our purchasing program from local groups would be more immediately profitable with profits initially being contributed to the development of alluvial production equipment and operations. As infrastructure and conditions permit, as mentioned, we also see the ability to implement gravity/wash plant(s) and a field smelting facility to further recovery after the Artisan hand operations recover initial gold.

**NEXT STAGE Plan:**

TASMD, acting as a Sierra Leone diamond development company focused on Sierra Leone. Our tasks and goals include:

To Establish various extraction relationships and heads of terms.

To Establish heads of terms with trading and purchase platforms or groups, in fair trade and traditional markets.

To Formulate joint ventures, including as such to expand with alluvial extractions, rare earths, and kimberlite projects.

To Evaluate resource targets.

To determine incremental levels of resource targets;

To conclude, as applicable, joint venture agreements, including with local communities and artisanal cooperatives.

### **Diamond.**

It has been confirmed that diamond in Sierra Leone is historically mined mainly from alluvial deposits at the Bo, the Kenema, and the Kono districts along the drainages of the Bafi, the Mano, the Moa, the Sewa, and the Woyie Rivers. The diamond producing areas include our Target area under our License with the Chiefdom, that is, Kenema, and mainly situated in the drainage area of the Sewa. As mentioned, alluvial diamond concentrations occur in river channel gravels, flood-plain gravels, terrace gravels, gravel residues in soils and swamps.

In 2012, the Kimberley Process Certification Scheme reported total rough diamond production to be 541,166 carats, which represented a 52% increase from production in 2011.

Essentially, All diamond output was exported.

2012-2014:

The average value per carat of Sierra Leone's diamond: \$302 per carat.

Gem-quality to industrial-quality ratio: about 80% gem-quality and 20% industrial-quality diamond.

### **Gold:**

At present, the main gold production in Sierra Leone comes from alluvial deposits. Notwithstanding the limited gold exports in recent years, Sierra Leone is thought to be well-endowed with gold deposits.

### **Rare Earths:**

Sierra Leone: Assays by ALS Chemex in Sparks, Nevada identified several rare earths contained in the black sands with gold as follows: Lanthanum, Scandium, Thallium, Cerium, Dysprosium, Hafnium, Lutetium, Niobium, Neodymium, Praesodymium, Tantalum and Zircon.
